WHEREAS, WritersCorps was one of 50 organizations across the country which received the 2010 President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities' National Arts and Humanities Youth Program Award among more than 200 semifinalists; and

WHEREAS, this award is the highest national honor bestowed on youth development programs in the United States, and,

WHEREAS, A WritersCorps staff and student were flown to the White House in fall 2010 to receive the award from First Lady Michelle Obama in a special ceremony; and;

WHEREAS, No grant cycle is designated with this award, however the Arts Commission will spend it between 7/1/2010 and 6/30/2011, and,

WHEREAS, WritersCorp does not require an ASO amendment; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors allows for the retroactive accepting and has expending of this President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities award, a federal pass through to the San Francisco Arts Commission from the Friends of the San Francisco

Public Library, waiving the inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Arts Commission's request, which be carried out in accordance with all grant requirements and may be spent and reported upon accordingly.
