Resolution recognizing the formation of the 2016 and 2017 Super Bowl Bid Committee and declaring the Board of Supervisor's support to host the Super Bowl in 2016 and 2017.

WHEREAS, San Francisco was among two metropolitan areas the National Football League (NFL) asked to submit bids to host the Super Bowl in February 2016, the 50th anniversary game of the annual NFL Super Bowl and February 2017; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is pleased to announce in partnership with the San Francisco 49ers and a San Francisco Bay Area regional bid committee it is a finalist to host the Super Bowl in 2016 and 2017; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors would like to thank CEO of the San Francisco 49ers Jed York, Goodby, Silverstein & Partners and the Super Bowl Bid Committee's members, including Chair Daniel Lurie, Charles Schwab, Joe Saunders, Condoleezza Rice, Lloyd Dean, Charlotte Shultz, Joe D'Alessandro, Laurene Powell, Willie L. Brown, Pat Gallagher, Mary Murphy, Gideon Yu, Chris Kelly, Jim Wunderman, Ron Conway, Thomas Keller and Carl Guardino; and

WHEREAS, If the Bid Committee is successful in securing either Super Bowl, it will be the second time the Bay Area and region has hosted this sporting event, and the first for San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco and San Francisco Bay Area regional bid committee intend to leave a lasting legacy for Bay Area Youth with Chair Daniel Laurie setting a target of raising \$10 million for youth programs; and the NFL has historically matched these funds for an additional \$1 million to promote this effort; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco city officials plan to host events, parades, parties and entertainment to visitors and local residents in the lead-up; and

WHEREAS, Social media and the Twitter #SFSuperbowl hashtag, have already played a huge role in building awareness and momentum of the Super Bowl bid; and

WHEREAS, The Super Bowl have been reported to generate an estimated \$300 million to \$500 million in overall economic activity for the Host city; and

WHEREAS, The bid for the region is expected to highlight the area's beautiful sights, world renowned destinations like the Wine Country, vast options for dining and hotel accommodations and showcase our recent public transportation success for the America's Cup races; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco has a tremendous track record of hosting major events simultaneously, such as the first weekend in October 2012 when a Giants baseball playoff game, America's Cup World Series regatta, Fleet Week and the Hardly Strictly Bluegrass music festival coincided; and
