Resolution commemorating the 150th anniversary of the issuance of the Emancipation Proclamation.

WHEREAS, 2013 marks the 150th anniversary of the Emancipation Proclamation, issued by President Abraham Lincoln on January 1,1863; and

WHEREAS, The Emancipation Proclamation, one of the most influential documents in American history declared "that all persons held as slaves" within Confederate territory "are, and henceforward shall [forever] be free"; and

WHEREAS, After three years of a violent Civil War, the Emancipation Proclamation called for and facilitated the freedom of over four million enslaved African Americans under the Confederacy; and

WHEREAS, The Emancipation Proclamation required the Union Army and Navy to accept over 186,000 African American men into their ranks giving them an opportunity to serve their country; and

WHEREAS, The Emancipation Proclamation ordered both the Union Army and the Navy to emancipate all enslaved African Americans when taking control of any Confederate territory; and

WHEREAS, The Emancipation Proclamation significantly affected the attitudes and opinions that all Americans held about slavery and was instrumental in bringing an end to nearly two and a half centuries of American slavery; and

WHEREAS, The Emancipation Proclamation was never challenged in court; and

WHEREAS, As a result of the issuance of the Emancipation Proclamation, slavery was officially abolished in the United States with the passage of the Thirteenth Amendment in 1865; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That on the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the issuance of the Emancipation Proclamation, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the immeasurable value that the Emancipation Proclamation had on American history and particularly on the history of African Americans.
