WHEREAS, On behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) and the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) are preparing to release a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the 2014-2015 CDBG, ESG and HOPWA Programs; and

WHEREAS, The RFP is in concert with San Francisco's 2010-2014 Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Plan was approved by HUD in 2010; and

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Plan details the five goals for the CDBG, ESG and HOPWA Programs: 1) Families and individuals are healthy and economically self-sufficient; 2) Neighborhoods and communities are strong, vibrant and stable; 3) Formerly homeless individuals and families are stable, supported and live in long-term housing; 4) Families and individuals have safe, healthy and affordable housing; and 5) Public housing developments that were severely distressed are thriving mixed-income communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors continues to support the CDBG, ESG and HOPWA Consolidated Plan goals, and the related 2014-2015 Request for Proposals to achieve these goals.
