WHEREAS, Internet cafes are setting up computers that allow customers to wager funds on gambling-themed games that simulate those found in casinos; and

WHEREAS, These internet cafes are thinly veiled gambling operations that have been able to operate because of poor definition in the law; and

WHEREAS, Local business owners have voiced concerns about the negative consequences of these establishments, including dramatic increases in criminal activity, increases in public nuisance complaints, and unnecessary drains on law enforcement resources; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco has recently reached a settlement against the proprietors, landlords, and software provider to Net Stop Business Center, a local internet café, after a year-long effort by community members and at great expense to the City's police and enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, In January of 2014, Assemblymember Rudy Salas introduced Assembly Bill 1439 (AB 1439) to fight the rising number of illegal sweepstakes gambling cafes throughout California, and provide local law enforcement the necessary tools for greater local control of this serious public safety issue; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby supports California Assembly Bill 1439 and directs the Clerk of the Board to communicate this support to the California State Legislature.
