WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for four existing positions, one Manager II (Job Class No. 0923) at .25 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator III (Job Class No. 2593) at .47 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator I (Job Class No. 2589) at .13 FTE and one IT Operations Support Admin II (Job Class No. 1092) for the period of June 1, 2014 through, May 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$23,152; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$556,874 from CDC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
