[Liquor License Transfer - 1501 Folsom Street]

Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 1501 Folsom Street/308 11th Street (District 6) to the same address, to Leticia M. Luna for LML Restaurants, Inc., will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.

WHEREAS, Leticia M. Luna is seeking the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 1501 Folsom Street/308-11th Street (District 6) to the same address for the expansion of premises, for LML Restaurants, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the following: 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, and 5:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday and on New Year's Eve, Christmas Eve, Thanksgiving Eve, The Fourth of July, and the Sunday before Labor Day and Memorial Day; 2) On the rooftop deck, sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be

permitted from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) every day of the week; 3) Security personnel shall be readily identifiable as security by wear distinctive clothing that has a logo of the establishment and the apparel shall state "SECURITY STAFF": 4) Between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and to until one half (1/2) hour past closing the petitioner(s) shall provide security personnel who shall maintain order therein and prevent any activity which would interfere with the quiet enjoyment of their property by nearby residents; 5) The sale of alcoholic beverages for off premises consumption is strictly prohibited; 6) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages; 7) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s); 8) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; 9) Loitering (defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee; 10) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed; 11) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences; 12) At no time shall the licensee(s) allow a third-party promoter to have any control over the marketing, management, operation, or staffing of this business; and 13) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee(s) within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee(s) shall remove

RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines that the transfer of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises license from 1501 Folsom Street/308-11th Street (District 6) to the same address for the expansion of premises, to Leticia M. Luna for LML Restaurants, Inc., will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the license with those conditions.
