WHEREAS, The California Natural Resources Agency's Strategic Growth Council is responsible for administration of the Urban Greening for Sustainable Communities Grant Program funded by the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84); and

WHEREAS, The Strategic Growth Council has awarded the City a grant in the amount of \$848,059 ("Grant") for Mansell Corridor Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, The terms and conditions of the Grant is detailed in the Agreement on file at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>150311</u> which is hereby declared to be part of this resolution as set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The Grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and WHEREAS, The Grant will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

Supervisors Avalos; Campos BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs as part of this Grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend an Urban Greening for Sustainable Communities Grant in the amount of \$848,059 for the Mansell Corridor Improvement Project in McLaren Park.
