Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$524,488 from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to participate in a program entitled Medical Monitoring Project for the period of June 1, 2015, through May 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to fund Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$524,488 for the period of June 1, 2015, through May 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on June 1, 2015, and ends on May 31, 2020, with years two, three, four and five subject to availability of funds and satisfactory progress of the project; and

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDC requires the City to enter into an agreement (Agreement), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. <u>150893</u>; which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to gather detailed information on HIVinfected patients receiving care in the United States; and

WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for three existing positions, one Manager I (Job Class No. 0922) at .25 FTE, one Health Program Coordinator III (Job Class No. 2593) at .40 FTE and one Health Program Coordinator II (Job Class No. 2591) at .15 FTE for the period of June 1, 2015 through, May 31, 2016; and

Supervisor Wiener BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$21,157; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$524,488 from CDC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
