On the morning of Tuesday, January 8, 2019, an 89-year old grandmother, mother, and member of our community was attacked at a park in Visitacion Valley. My staff and I have been working closely with Captain Hart of the Ingleside Police Station on following this case to bring justice for the family. This morning, we visited the grandmother and her family at the ICU in San Francisco General Hospital and were told that she is still in critical condition. It is heartbreaking to see this type of senseless violence in our community and no one should ever endure this level of barbarism. Our staff is working with City and community leaders to unite and set up a community meeting in Visitacion Valley in the coming days. We are absolutely committed stop this heartless violence from occurring in the future and we will fight hard to get the resources to bring a police substation to Leland Avenue including bilingual speaking officers and increase our Community Ambassadors Program to improve our public safety in all our communities.
