The General Plan Update is a forward-looking document that will serve as the blueprint for the City of South San Francisco's (City's) vision through the year 2040. The goals, policies, and actions in the General Plan Update will serve as a compass for decision-makers and will shape future plans and actions of the City. The General Plan Update anticipates approximately 14,312 net new housing units and approximately 42,297 net new employment opportunities by 2040. This revised document will replace the 1999 General Plan and will inform updates to the City's Zoning Ordinance.

The updated 2022 Climate Action Plan includes a community-wide inventory of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and identifies strategies and measures to reduce GHG emissions generated by existing and future uses in the City.
