MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Food Security Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Health Code, Sections 470.1 and 470.2, for the terms specified:

Chester Williams (residency requirement waived), seat 4, succeeding Bruce McKinney, resigned, must be a representative of a community-based organization that provides nutritional support and increases the food security of San Francisco residents, for an indefinite term.

Geoffrey Grier (residency requirement waived), seat 15, succeeding Simon Pitchford, resigned, must be a representative of a community-based organization that provides nutritional support and increases the food security of San Francisco residents, for an indefinite term; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Food Security Task Force has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicants Chester Williams and Geoffrey Grier, who are not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Food Security Task Force.
