[Concurring in the Continuation of the Declaration of Local Emergency - Flooding Affecting SFPUC's Moccasin Reservoir (Tuolumne County)]

Motion concurring in the continuation of the Declaration of Local Emergency by the Mayor and in the actions taken to meet the emergency of flooding affecting the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Moccasin Reservoir in Tuolumne County.

WHEREAS, On March 29, 2018, Mayor Mark E. Farrell declared a local emergency to exist, under Charter, Section 3.100(14), and California Government Code, Section 8630, in connection with flooding caused by a high intensity rain storm on March 22, 2018, in the vicinity of the town of Moccasin in Tuolumne County; on March 22, 2018, a total of five inches of rain fell that afternoon, causing a large flow of water and debris from Moccasin Creek to enter the SFPUC's Moccasin Reservoir, flooding nearby areas and causing damage to SFPUC property and equipment, including Moccasin Dam; the flooding has also impacted the water delivery conveyance capability from the Hetch Hetchy system to the SFPUC's Regional Water system; and

WHEREAS, On April 3, 2018, under the same statutory authorities, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency by Motion No. M18-41, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180293, where is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion, as if set forth fully herein; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has concluded that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril continues and requires a continued proclamation of the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has transmitted a copy of the continued Declaration of Local Emergency to the Board of Supervisors, dated, April 16, 2018, and such copy is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180402; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has directed the head of each department and agency to observe his or her proper relationship in the command structure of the Incident Command System, and be responsive to the orders and requests of the Lead Department designated to exercise supervision over his or her department during the course of this emergency; and

WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of California is hereby requested to include the area of the City of the City and County of San Francisco in any emergency declaration by the State, and is further requested to ensure that the City and County of San Francisco is included in any emergency declaration that may be issued by the President of the United States; and

WHEREAS, All departments of the City and County of San Francisco are strictly enjoined to cooperate with the requests for material and personnel resources by the Incident Command System staff of said City and County which is located in the Emergency Operations Center of the City and County of San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Government Code, Section 8630, provides that, when a local emergency has been declared, the governing body shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least once every 30 days until it is terminated by the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs with the continuation of the Declaration of Local Emergency issued by Mayor Mark E. Farrell on April 16, 2018, and in the actions taken by the Mayor to meet the emergency; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to agendize another motion concurring in the continuation of the Declaration of Local Emergency, in connection with flooding caused by the high intensity rain storm in the vicinity of the town of Moccasin in Tuolumne County, to be heard no later than 30 days from the date of passage of this Motion.
