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20	Section 1. Findings.
21	(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
22	ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources
23	Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
24	Supervisors in File No. 190049 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms
25	this determination.

Section 2. Chapter 41 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 41.4, to read as follows:

SEC. 41.4. DEFINITIONS.

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**Tourist or Transient Use**. Any use of a guest room for less than a <u>30</u>32-day term of tenancy by a party other than a Permanent Resident.

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Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Supervisor Peskin BOARD OF SUPERVISORS Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
