

1 [Accept and Expend Grant and Amend the Annual Salary Ordinance - Retroactive - Office of
2 Financial Empowerment Kindergarten to College Program - Mott Foundation - \$365,000]

3 **Ordinance retroactively authorizing the Office of Treasurer & the Tax Collector to**
4 **accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$365,000 from the Charles & Stuart Mott**
5 **Foundation for implementing the Office of Financial Empowerment Kindergarten to**
6 **College Program for the period of September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2021; and**
7 **amending Ordinance No. 170-19 (Annual Salary Ordinance File No. 190620 for FYs**
8 **2019-2020 and 2020-2021) to provide for the creation of one grant-funded Class 1844**
9 **Senior Management Assistant position (0.67 FTE).**

17 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

18 **Section 1. Findings.**

19 (a) The Office of Financial Empowerment in the Office of the Treasurer & Tax Collector
20 was awarded a \$365,000 grant from the Mott Foundation on March 19, 2019. The purpose of
21 the grant is to support refinement and an expansion of outreach and communications
22 campaign to increase the savings participation rate for families through the Kindergarten to
23 College program.

24 (b) The City and County of San Francisco established the Kindergarten to College
25 program in 2011 to provide college savings accounts for San Francisco Unified School District
kindergarteners with an initial deposit of \$50, provide a financial education curriculum, and

1 encourage savings for higher education.

2 (c) Now managing over 35,000 accounts, Kindergarten to College serves every family
3 in the San Francisco public school system but is especially attuned to low-income families and
4 families of color who face the greatest barriers to post-secondary education. Families have
5 saved more than \$4.2 million for post-secondary education through the Kindergarten to
6 College program and, including San Francisco's contribution to accounts, families now have
7 more than \$6.9 million saved for their children's future.

8 (d) The grant period is from September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2021.

9 **Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.**

10 (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Treasurer & Tax
11 Collector to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San
12 Francisco, funds from the Mott Foundation in the amount of \$365,000 to conduct outreach to
13 families in the Kindergarten to College program and to provide incentives for low-income
14 families to contribute to college savings accounts.

15 (b) The grant does not require matching funds from the City.

16 (c) The grant includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$33,182.

17 **Section 3. Grant funded positions; Amendment to FY 2019-2020 and FY 2020-21**
18 **Annual Salary Ordinance.**

19 The hereinafter designated sections and items of Ordinance No. 170-19 (Annual Salary
20 Ordinance File No. 190620 for FY 2019-2020 and FY2020-2021) are hereby amended to add
21 one position in the Office of the Treasurer & Tax Collector as follows:
