[Assignment and Assumption Agreement - California Housing Finance Agency - Department of Public Health and Rosa Parks II, L.P. - 1239 Turk Street ("Willie B. Kennedy Senior Housing Development") - \$300,000 - FY2017-2018]

Resolution accepting the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Assignment and Assumption Agreement Loan and related loan documents between the California Housing Finance Agency, a public instrumentality and political subdivision of the State of California (Assignor), and the San Francisco Department of Public Health (Assignee) for the benefit of the Willie B. Kennedy senior housing development, located at 1239 Turk Street (Project), with Rosa Parks II, L.P., a California limited partnership as owner; and authorizing the Mayor on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to accept the Assignment and Assumption Agreement from Assignor so that Assignee may monitor all ongoing oversight and service obligations for the Project under the MHSA Permanent Loan Documents and the MHSA Housing Program in accordance with the San Francisco Mental Health Services Act Integrated Plan in the Ioan amount of \$300,000 for FY2017-2018.

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), enacted through a California ballot initiative (Proposition 63) in 2004, provides funding to support new and expanded county mental health programs; and

WHEREAS, The California Housing Finance Agency (Assignor) has authority to provide the capital financing for special needs housing and originated a permanent loan (MHSA Permanent Loan) pursuant to the MHSA Housing Program to Rosa Parks II, L.P., (Borrower) in the amount of \$300,000 to support the construction of the Willie B. Kennedy Apartments located at 1239 Turk Street, which has three units dedicated to serve the MHSA senior population, as described in the MHSA Permanent Loan, MHSA Regulatory Agreement,

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Promissory Note and MHSA Deed of Trust dated July 1, 2017, collectively referred to as the "MHSA Permanent Loan Documents;" and

WHEREAS, Assignor and the San Francisco Department of Public Health (Assignee) determined that under the particular circumstances of the Project, an assignment to the Assignee of all rights and obligations pursuant to the MHSA Permanent Loan Documents and related obligations is appropriate in that Assignee is already monitoring the MHSA housing units at the Project as the county implementing agency of the San Francisco MHSA Housing Program; and

WHEREAS, The Borrower shall indemnify Assignor and Assignee and hold their employees, officers, agents and board members harmless against all claims, losses, liabilities, judgments, and costs which arise out of or in connection with the Assignment and the MHSA Permanent Loan Documents, and

WHEREAS, The administrative and direct costs of monitoring the MHSA Program are included in the San Francisco MHSA Housing Program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby authorized to accept the Assignment and Assumption Agreement of the MHSA Permanent Loan Documents (the "Assignment and Assumption Agreement") for the benefit of the Project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the acceptance of the Assignment and Assumption Agreement of the MHSA Permanent Loan Documents for the benefit of the Project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the Assignment and Assumption Agreement; and, be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions heretofore taken by the officers of the City with respect to the acceptance of the Assignment and Assumption Agreement as consistent with the documents herein and this Resolution, are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract being fully executed by all parties, the San Francisco Department of Public Health shall provide the final contract to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
