Resolution authorizing Public Works to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$15,000,000 from the United States Department of Transportation for the FY 2018 Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development Transportation Discretionary Grant to fund the construction of the Public Works' Better Market Street Phase 1 project for the period of June 2020 through June 2025.

WHEREAS, The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018 (Pub. L. 115–141, March 23, 2018) (FY 2018 Appropriations Act) appropriated \$1.5 billion to be awarded by the United
States Department of Transportation (USDOT) for National Infrastructure Investments; and WHEREAS, On April 27, 2018, the United States Office of the Secretary of
Transportation released a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the Department of
Transportation's National Infrastructure Investments under the FY 2018 Appropriations Act; and

WHEREAS, Funds for the FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grants program were for capital investments in surface transportation infrastructure and were awarded on a competitive basis for projects that have a significant local or regional impact; and

WHEREAS, On July 18, 2018, San Francisco Public Works (SFPW) submitted a 2018 BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant application for the Better Market Street Phase 1 project; and

WHEREAS, In December 2018, USDOT released the 2018 BUILD Award Fact Sheet which awarded \$15,000,000 to SFPW for the Better Market Street Phase 1 project construction phase; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Highway Administration and the California Department of Transportation will administer the FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Grant for the Better Market Street Phase 1 project; and

WHEREAS, The funding plan includes sufficient non-federal matching funds to meet the required 20% local match, including Proposition K Transportation Sales Tax funds and Proposition A General Obligation Bond funds; and

WHEREAS, The funding does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance (ASO) amendment; and

WHEREAS, The total construction budget, which includes the grant and match funds, include indirect costs totaling \$10,239,372 million; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors authorizes SFPW to accept and expend up to \$15,000,000 in FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant Funds for the project described above; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFPW, by adopting this Resolution, commits to providing the required local match to the FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Grant; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Public Works or his or her designee is authorized to execute all required documents for receipt of FY 2018 BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant Funds.
