Resolution retroactively authorizing the Police Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$298,414 from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency to purchase an underwater remote operated vehicle, for the period of September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2022, and waiving indirect costs.

WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), under the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), appropriates annual funding for the Port Security Grant Program (PSGP); and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) is to promote sustainable, risk-based efforts to protect critical port infrastructure from terrorism; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department (SFPD) applied for PSGP funding and was awarded \$298,414 from the FY2019 PSGP appropriation to purchase an underwater remote operated vehicle (ROV); and

WHEREAS, The award period is September 1, 2019, through August 31, 2022; and WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, This grant requires the City to provide matching funds worth 25% of the total project budget, or \$99,471; and

WHEREAS, SFPD will provide matching funds worth 25% of the total project budget, or \$99,471; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Police Department (SFPD) is authorized to accept and expend a grant from the Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS/FEMA) in the amount of \$298,414; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police, or his designee, is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco.
