9 \$451,544 to the Office of the District Attorney for the County Victim Services (XC) Program;

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support counties across California, and
12 the City of Los Angeles, in providing direct services to victims; and

13 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary
14 Ordinance (ASO) Amendment; and


15 WHEREAS, The grant includes a required match of 20% of the project budget or
16 \$112,886; the sources of matching funds are the District Attorney's Office general fund and
17 through volunteer hours; and

18 WHEREAS, The grant includes provision for indirect costs of \$50,276; now,
19 therefore, be it


20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the
