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3 **Resolution declaring the results of the March 5, 2024, Consolidated Presidential**

6 WHEREAS, A Consolidated Presidential Primary Election was conducted in the City  
7 and County of San Francisco on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, which placed before the electorate  
8 candidates for Judge of the Superior Court and local ballot measures; and

9 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Director of Elections for the City and County of San  
10 Francisco, has certified the results of the Consolidated Presidential Primary Election, a copy  
11 of which is contained in Board File No. 240315, and which is incorporated herein by  
12 reference; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That under California Elections Code, Sections 9269 and 15400, this  
14 Board of Supervisors affirms the Director of Elections' certified results for the City and County

14 PROPOSITION E: Police Department Policies and Procedures

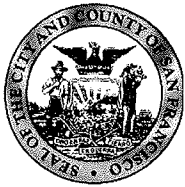
