5	WHEREAS, The Senate filibuster was not a part of the original design of the U.S.				
6	Senate and was created unintentionally in 1806 after Senators removed the "previous				
7	question" motion in from the Senate rules; and				
8	WHEREAS, The use of the Senate filibuster was rare throughout much of the 19th				
9	century, and when employed it was generally used to delay and influence but not obstruct				
10	legislation, with most filibustered legislation eventually passing; and				
11	WHEREAS, The Senate filibuster began to be used successfully to preserve slavery				
12	prior to the Civil War and the block voting rights for Black citizens during Reconstruction; and				
13	WHEREAS, The Senate filibuster was employed to actively stop Civil Rights legislation				
14	including 200 bills outlawing lynching, bills ending poll taxes and employment discrimination,				
15	and the Civil Rights Acts of 1957 and 1964; and				
16	WHEREAS, The Senate rules were changed in the 1970s to reduce the cloture vote to				
17	60, to institute a "tracking system" and the "silent filibuster" that allows other legislation to				
18	proceed while a bill is being filibustered, and to allow a Senator to filibuster without even				
19	needing to be present; and				
20	WHEREAS, The Senate filibuster rule has created a de facto supermajority				
21	requirement to pass any legislation; and				
22	WHEREAS, The Senate filibuster has been weaponized to a greater extent than ever				
23	before to become a tool of anti-democratic obstruction in order to block the will of the people				
24	and prevent legislation for the betterment of our residents from passing, including landmark

1	pieces of legislation that would improve the civil rights, workers' rights, and health and safety
2	of all people in the United States; and
3	WHEREAS, Ending the filibuster is a necessary first step toward enacting a
4	comprehensive economic recovery plan following COVID-19; and
5	WHEREAS, Article I, Section 5, Clause 2 of the United States Constitution allows each
6	House Congress to determine the Rules of its Proceedings; now, therefore, be it
7	RESOLVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors supports the elimination of the
8	Senate filibuster; and, be it;
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California
10	Senate Delegation, Senators Dianne Feinstein and Alex Padilla, and President Joe Biden to
11	support the elimination of the Senate filibuster.
