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4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Children Youth and Their**
5 **Families to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$286,020.73 from the United**
6 **States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and administered by the**
7 **California Board of State and Community Corrections, for the Coronavirus Emergency**
8 **Supplemental Funding program to support the Adult Probation Department, Juvenile**
9 **Probation Department, Public Defender’s Office, Police Department, District Attorney’s**
10 **Office, and Sheriff’s Office to meet coronavirus re-entry related equipment, services,**
11 **supplies and overtime needs for the project period of March 31, 2021, through January**
12 **31, 2023.**

14 WHEREAS, The Department of Children Youth and Their Families (DCYF) applied for
15 funding on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco for the Coronavirus Emergency
16 Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program, funded through the United States Department of
17 Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and administered by the California Board of State and
18 Community Corrections; and

19 WHEREAS, The Board of State and Community Corrections will allocate a grant of
20 \$286,020.73 for the City and County of San Francisco to prepare for and respond to the
21 coronavirus re-entry related equipment, services, supplies and overtime needs of the Adult
22 Probation Department, Juvenile Probation Department, Public Defender’s Office, Department,
23 District Attorney’s Office, and Sheriff’s Office for the project period beginning March 31, 2021,
24 and ending on January 31, 2023; and

25 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

1 WHEREAS, DCYF proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program
2 expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes DCYF to retroactively accept
4 and expend the grant of \$286,020.73 from the Board of State and Community Corrections to
5 prepare and respond to coronavirus re-entry related equipment, services, supplies and
6 overtime needs of the Adult Probation Department, Juvenile Probation Department, Public
7 Defender's Office, Police Department, District Attorney's Office, and Sheriff's Office; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor, or alternatively the Executive Director of
9 DCYF, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco in
10 connection with the CESF Program award, and to enter into, execute, and deliver any and all
11 documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to be awarded the CESF Program
12 award, and all amendments thereto, including the grant proposal for this funding and the
13 Grant Agreement with the Board of State and Community Corrections; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
15 supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to abide by
17 the terms and conditions of the CESF Program Grant Agreement as set forth by the Board of
18 State and Community Corrections; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully
20 executed by all parties, DCYF shall provide a copy to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into
21 the official file.
