WHEREAS, There is a continued need to provide mental health outpatient and specialized mental health treatment services for children, youth and families; and to provide behavioral health managed care services; and

WHEREAS, Through multiple Request for Proposals (RFP) processes, RFP 33-2016, issued on November 2, 2016, RFQ 17-2016, issued on July 20, 2016, RFP 1-2017, issued on March 7, 2017, and RFQ 13-2017, issued on September 28, 2017, DPH selected Seneca Family of Agencies dba Seneca Center (Seneca Center) to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, DPH entered into an agreement on July 1, 2018, to provide these behavioral health services for four years, with the term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2022, with one six-year option to extend, in an amount not to exceed \$40,529,444; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the original agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180828; and

WHEREAS, DPH wishes to amend the agreement to continue providing mental health outpatient and specialized mental health treatment services in alignment with the length of the term anticipated in RFQ 13-2017, by extending the term by five and one half years, from June 30, 2022, through December 31, 2027, increasing the contract by \$16,585,042 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$57,114,486 and for a total agreement term of July 1, 2018, through December 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the Charter requires approval of the Board of Supervisors for contracts requiring anticipated expenditures exceeding \$10 million; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to execute Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Seneca Center to provide mental health outpatient and specialized mental health treatment services, to extend the term by five and one half years, from June 30, 2022, for a total agreement term of July 1, 2018, through December 31, 2027, and increasing the contract by \$16,585,042 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$57,114,486; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of Public Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to the contract, prior to its final execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not otherwise materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the contract, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract being fully executed by all parties, the Director of Health and/or the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser shall provide the final contacts to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official File No. 220333.
