WHEREAS, Because the entire award of the Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant Program will be used to improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources for our sworn members, it is requested that indirect costs be waived to maximize use of available grant funds on the program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

Department to accept and expend the grant of \$1,407,675.74 from the California Board of
State and Community Corrections; and, be it
