WHEREAS, On June 30, 2020, the City and County of San Francisco (City) and 333 Valencia Owner, L.L.C. (Landlord) entered into a lease for office space to be used by the Department of Public Health at 333 Valencia Street in San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The lease, the term of which began on April 28, 2021, obligated Landlord to complete base building work before the City took occupancy of the building; and

WHEREAS, After the City took occupancy of the property, a dispute arose between the City and Landlord about building systems located inside closets that limited the amount of space available for storage by the City; and

WHEREAS, To resolve the dispute, Landlord proposes to provide the City additional storage space and a rent credit of \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health and the Real Estate Division each recommends the proposed settlement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.24(b), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle and compromise the claim in its entirety with Landlord providing the City additional storage space and a rent credit of \$50,000; other material terms include the City providing Landlord a full release of all claims.
