6	WHEREAS, May 18th is the birthday of Vincent Chin, who was brutally murdered in a		
7	hate crime in Detroit in 1982, fueling a national Asian American activist movement that		
8	continues to this day; and		
9	WHEREAS, Every day, youth of all ages suffer from being bullied in schools and online		
10	across the country; and		
11	WHEREAS, In the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community, this		
12	problem is often compounded by cultural, religious, and linguistic barriers that can keep these		
13	youth from seeking and receiving help; and		
14	WHEREAS, Certain AAPI populations – including South Asian, Muslim, Sikh,		
15	Micronesian, LGBT, immigrant, and limited English proficient youth – are more likely to be the		
16	targets of bullying, including half of Asian American students, two-thirds of Sikh American		
17	students, and half of Muslim American students; and		
18	WHEREAS, The COVID-19 pandemic has led to a staggering rise in bullying,		
19	discrimination, and hate crimes in the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community;		
20	and		
21	WHEREAS, Between March 19 and December 31, 2020, Stop AAPI Hate has received		
22	2,808 reported incidents of racism and discrimination targeting Asian Americans across the		
23	U.S., with vulnerable populations experiencing increased attacks and youth under 20 years		
24	old making up 13.6% of cases; and

1	WHEREAS, Recent reports, including a survey by the U.S. Education Department,		
2	demonstrate that AAPI students are returning to school at a lower rate than their peers, and		
3	almost 7 in 10 Asian American K-12 students were still learning online only, with this		
4	hesitancy to return to in-person learning partially attributed to the increase in hate against		
5	AAPI communities; now, therefore, be it		
6	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco		
7	will continue to denounce all incidents of hate against the Asian American community		
8	surrounding the COVID-19 crisis, in particular those targeting youth and young people; and,		
9	be it		
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San		
11	Francisco urge our educational institutions to include school-based curriculum to combat the		
12	rise of hate and bullying against our AAPI youth; and, be it		
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That as part of Asian Pacific American Heritage Month and in		
14	honor of Vincent Chin, the Board of Supervisors declares May 18, 2021, as Asian American		
15	and Pacific Islander Day Against Bullying and Hate in the City and County of San Francisco;		
16	and, be it		
17	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall transmit a		
18	copy of this Resolution to the San Francisco Board of Education and Superintendent Vincent		
19	Matthews.
