to School Program for the period of September 1, 2014, through August 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized to accept and expend these funds, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130890; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Transportation Commission awarded San Francisco
Department of Public Health an additional funding of \$360,000 for the San Francisco Safe
Routes to School Program for the period of October 1, 2016, though August 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on September 1, 2014, and ends on August 31, 2017, with additional funding for the period of October 1, 2016, through August 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of this additional funding is to expand the following: San Francisco Safe Routes to School communication and evaluation, parent/caregiver outreach, San Francisco Safe Routes to School assemblies on pedestrian and bike safety, hands-on bike education to middle schools, reach of Walk and Roll to School Day 2016, reach of school transportation toolkits, and annual school commute study to school year 2016-2017; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Safe Routes to School Program does not contain indirect costs because San Francisco Department of Public Health does not have an approved indirect cost agreement with the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) allowing for indirect costs in the budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That San Francisco Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$360,000 from Metropolitan Transportation Commission as programmed by San Francisco County Transportation Authority; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That San Francisco Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
