15 Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby

21 **SEC. 3.1-109. ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF.**

22 (a) **Disclosure Category 2.** Persons in this category shall disclose all interests in

24 (b) **Disclosure Category 3.** Persons in this category shall disclose all investments

25 and business positions in business entities, interests in real property, and income from any

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1 source that is subject to the regulatory, permit or licensing authority of the Department of  
2 Administrative Services.

3 (c) **Disclosure Category 4.** Persons in this category shall disclose all investments  
4 and business positions in business entities and income from any source which provides, or  
5 contracts with the City and County of San Francisco and its Purchasing Department to provide  
6 commodities or services to the City and County of San Francisco, or has provided  
7 commodities or services to the City and County of San Francisco within the last two years.

8 (d) **Disclosure Category 5.** Persons in this category shall disclose all investments  
9 and business positions in business entities and income from any source which provides, or  
10 contracts with the City and County of San Francisco to provide, or has provided within the last  
11 two years, commodities or services to either the Division of the Purchasing Department to  
12 which the person is assigned, or the Department (other than the Purchasing Department), to  
13 which the person is assigned.





