- (c) This Board finds that the actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent with the General Plan and with the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1 for the reasons set forth in Planning Commission Resolution No. ____18550___ and the Board hereby incorporates such reasons herein by reference.
