17 Section 1. On February 1, 2012, pursuant to Board of Supervisors Resolution 11-12
18 [Transfer of Assets, Obligations, and Functions to the City as Successor Agency for the
19 Redevelopment Agency As Required By State Law] the City and County of San Francisco
20 ("City") became the successor agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County
21 of San Francisco ("Successor Agency"). The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and
22 implements, on behalf of the City as the Successor Agency, Amendment #2 amending the
23 2009-2011 Memorandum of Agreement between the Redevelopment Agency of the City and
24 County of San Francisco and International Federation of Professional and Technical
25 Engineers, Local 21, AFL-CIO (Management/Supervisory Unit) by extending the term of the


