THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby implements the provisions of the  
amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding between the International Association of  
Bridge, Structural Ornamental, Reinforced Iron Workers, Riggers and Machinery Movers and  
the City and County of San Francisco, providing for additional compensation for Port  
employees of the Maintenance Department in Classification 9346 Fusion Welder, who are  
assigned to work in watch-standing, maintenance and/or repair of container cranes for all  
hours actually worked on cranes at the crane site, effective July 1, 1999 through the  
remaining term of the Memorandum of Understanding. The amended provisions so  
implemented are on file in the office of the Board of Supervisors.




