6 WHEREAS, The condition of the sidewalks along the South Sunset
7 Playground have been the subject of complaints for a number of years;
8 and,

9 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works-Bureau of Street-Use and
10 Mapping found in March of 1998 that all of the sidewalks fronting the
11 playground needed repair due to holes or cracks, raised or sunken
12 squares, and tree root problems; and,

13 WHEREAS, The sidewalks were resurveyed in March 2000 in response
14 to a complaint filed with the Board of Supervisors and the Department
15 of Public Works; and

16 Whereas, The Department of Public Works-Bureau of Street-Use and
17 Mapping have determined that the sidewalks are under the jurisdiction
18 of the Department of Recreation and Parks; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Department of Recreation and Parks arrange to
20 address these hazardous conditions as soon as possible; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Recreation and Parks
22 convey to the Board of Supervisors in writing the timeline by which
23 they will have the repairs completed.


