

1 [Zoning - Extension of Planning Commission Review Period]

2 EXTENDING THE PRESCRIBED TIME WITHIN WHICH THE PLANNING COMMISSION
3 MAY RENDER ITS DECISION ON A PROPOSED ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE
4 PLANNING CODE TO ADOPT AN INCLUSIONARY AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM.

5 WHEREAS, On July 10, 2000, the Board of Supervisors initiated the process to amend
6 the Municipal Code, Part II, Chapter II (Planning Code), when the Honorable Mark Leno
7 introduced and the Honorable Gavin Newsom, Sue Bierman and Leslie Katz co-sponsored a
8 proposed ordinance to adopt an inclusionary affordable housing program, a copy of which is
9 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001262; and,

10 WHEREAS, On July 13, 2000 the proposed ordinance was referred to the
11 Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has requested additional time to review
13 the proposed ordinance; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d)
15 may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to
16 render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of
17 Supervisors; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the
19 Planning Commission an additional 90 days to review the proposed ordinance and render its
20 decision; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That by this resolution, the Board hereby extends the prescribed
22 time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed
23 ordinance to adopt an inclusionary affordable housing program, a copy of which is on file with
24 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001262, for an additional 90 days.


