Resolution supporting Senate Bill 531 (Sher), establishing a renewable energy portfolio standard requiring that 20% of California's energy come from renewable resources by 2010.

WHEREAS, The California Energy Commission estimates that over half of California's energy needs could be met through solar, wind and geothermal energy; and

WHEREAS, A Renewable Portfolio Standard will help shield our economy from the price spikes of the volatile fossil fuel market that have contributed to the energy crisis; and

WHEREAS, California's reliance on natural gas for power production is a key driver in current high electricity costs; and

WHEREAS, Renewable energy is cost-effective, and in some cases, already cheaper than conventional energy sources; and

WHEREAS, Renewable energy systems can be built much quicker than big fossil fuel plants; and

WHEREAS, Ten percent of California's energy already comes from renewable resources – increasing that percentage further will yield significant environmental and economic benefits; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco is pursuing a competitively bid request for proposals that will result in installation of 50 MW of solar power generation on San Francisco rooftops and is actively exploring other renewable energy sources such as wind; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco supports Senate Bill 531, establishing a renewable energy portfolio standard that 20% of California's energy come from renewable resources by 2010.
