WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco has undertaken a certain project designated "Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program – San Francisco Satellite Initiative," to be funded from funds made available through the U.S. Department of Justice – Office of Justice Programs (herein referred to as OJP); and,

WHEREAS, This grant funding will provide much needed computer equipment and specialized training to combat the ever-increasing area of child exploitation and cyberenticement; and,

WHEREAS, Grant funding under the Investigative Satellite Initiative will assist in the development and enhancement of the SFPD Internet Unit by providing specialized training in the investigation of child exploitation over the internet, and prevention resources to combat child pornography distribution; and,

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget, and require the city to assume any liability arising out of the performance of this grant agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend continued funding for this project from OJP; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
