4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH),**
5 **Community Substance Abuse Services (CSAS), to accept retroactively and expend**
6 **funds in the amount of \$154,402 for the first year of a three year grant from the**
7 **California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (CADP) to reduce youth violence**
8 **and substance abuse in San Francisco; for the period of June 28, 2001 to June 30,**
9 **2002.**

11 WHEREAS, SFDPH, CSAS has applied for and been awarded funds in the amount of
12 \$154,402 for the first year of a three year grant from CADP to reduce youth violence and
13 substance abuse in San Francisco; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CADP requires the City to
15 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with Clerk of the Board
16 of Supervisors in File No. 020109, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
17 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$15,440; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, CSAS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
21 expend the first year of a three year grant in the amount of \$154,402 from CADP; and, be it


22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, CSAS is hereby authorized to accept and
23 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement
24 pursuant to the San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
2 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position
4 created under the grant as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the
5 grant expires; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of
7 Health to enter into similar agreements with CADP if the grant recurs or is renewed.


