The Engineer's Report is on file with the City Clerk and is available for inspection on the City's website www.dalycity.org.



SUMMARY OF INTRODUCED ORDINANCES CITY OF BELMONT AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELMONT CODIFYING DISTRICT-BASED ELECTIONS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02. ESTABLISHING THE SEQUENCE OF COUNCIL MEMBER ELECTIONS BY-DISTRICTS, SETTING THE TERM AND INITIAL ELECTION DATE FOR THE ELECTIVE MAYOR, AND REORGANIZING THE CITY CODE TO INCORPORATE THE CHANGE IN METHOD OF ELECTION On April 12, 2022, the Belmont City Council introduced an ordinance codifying district-based elections, establishing the sequence of councilmember elections by -districts, establishing the office of mayor and setting the term of office for the mayor and initial election, and reorganizing the city code to incorporate the change in method of council elections. Councilmembers will be elected from districts 1 and 3 in November 2022 and districts 2 and 4 in November 2022. The district boundaries and the numbering of districts is shown on a map adopted by City Council Resolution 2022-027. The initial election for MAYOR will be in November 2022. The mayor will have a 2-year term of office. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELMONT AMENDING CANNABIS REGULATIONS IN THE BELMONT ZONING ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE NO. 360) AND ADOPTING CANNABIS RETAIL AND DISTRIBUTION COMBINING DISTRICTS On April 12, 2022, the Belmont City Council introduced an ordinance Amending the Cannabis Regulation in the Belmont Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. 360). The amendments will establish S-3 Cannabis Retail & Distribution Combining District and S-4 Cannabis Distribution Combining District as locations in the city where retail and distribution cannabis uses are allowable, and establish use permit, development standards and performance standards for those uses. The amendments limit the number of retail uses to three and the number of distribution uses to four. The ordinance will be reviewed by the planning commission and then return to the City Council for a public hearing scheduled for June 14, 2022 at 7:00 p.m., at Belmont City Hall, One Twin Pines Lane, Belmont, California, to consider any planning commission recommendations and to receive public input. ORDINANCE NO. 1456 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DALY CITY AMENDING SECTION 2.58.060 OF TITLE 2 OF THE DALY CITY MUNICIPAL CODE RE: SMALL BUSINESS COMMISSION MEETINGS

The City Council of the City of Daly City, DOES ORDAIN as follows: SECTION 1. Section 2.58.060 of Chapter 2.58 of the Daly City Municipal Code is hereafter amended to read as follows:

Chapter 2.58 SMALL BUSINESS COMMISSION

Section 2.58.060 Meetings 2.58.060 Meetings.

The small business commission shall hold a minimum of twelve (12) regular meetings in each calendar year at the City Council Chambers located in City Hall, 333 90th Street, Daly City, California. The commission shall meet on the second Thursday of every month at seven p.m. of such day. If at any time a regular meeting falls on a holiday, such regular meeting shall be held on the following business day.

Three members of the commission shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A majority of the quorum shall have the authority to act on any matter regularly coming before the commission. Meetings may be adjourned, or special meetings called in compliance with the provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act (commencing with Government Code Section 54950) or as may hereafter be amended.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, provision or part of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provision to other person or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect and, to that end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. Environmental Determination. The City Council finds, pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 15378, that this Ordinance is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in that it is not a project as provided by the Act, in that it does not have a potential for resulting in a detrimental physical change in the environment directly or ultimately, as provided in Title 14, Section 15378(a), and that it is also exempt under the definition of "project" in Section 15378(b)(3) in that it concerns general policy and procedure making.

SECTION 4. Effective Date and Publication: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage. This Ordinance shall be published according to law. Introduced this 28th day of March, 2022
