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[Agreement - Retroactive - Community Youth Center of San Francisco - Academic Support; Beacon at Aptos; Year-Round & Summer Programs; and Teen Arts - Not to Exceed \$13,724,500]

Resolution retroactively approving an agreement between the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, and the Community Youth Center of San Francisco for four programs: Academic Support; Beacon at Aptos; Year-Round & Summer Programs; and Teen Arts; for a term of five years from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of \$13,724,500; and to authorize the Department of Children Youth and Their Families to make necessary, non-material changes to the Agreement before its execution that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement or this Resolution.

WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for its 2024–2029 funding cycle; and WHEREAS, Community Youth Center of San Francisco submitted proposals for four programs under RFP Result Area: All Children And Youth Are Ready To Learn And Succeed In School; and

WHEREAS, The four programs are: Academic Support; Beacon at Aptos; Year-Round & Summer Programs; and Teen Arts; and

WHEREAS, Community Youth Center of San Francisco was awarded funding in all four programs; and

WHEREAS, Under the Academic Support Program, Community Youth Center of San Francisco will provide academic coaching, tutoring and educational support for 40 youth at Aptos Middle School, Balboa and San Francisco International High Schools; and

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WHEREAS, Under the Beacon at Aptos Program, Community Youth Center of San Francisco will provide beacon program framework that is student-centered, grounded in partnership and focused on the needs of students, families and the school community; and

WHEREAS, Under the Year-Round and Summer Programs, Community Youth Center of San Francisco will provide services to a total of 230 youth from kindergarten to high school through comprehensive programs tailored to address Summer Learning Loss; and

WHEREAS, Under the Teen Arts Program, Community Youth Center of San Francisco will provide programming for multiple cohorts of 18 youth, totaling 90 youth, in the disciplines of film and music production, screen-printing, pottery, dance, photography, digital media and DIY art studio; and

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, The proposed Agreement contained in File No. 241126, is substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Agreement in substantially the form contained in File No. 241126; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes Department of Children, Youth and Families to make any modifications to the Agreement, prior to its final execution by all parties, that Department of Children, Youth and Their Families determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully executed by all parties, Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 241126; this requirement and obligation resides with the Department, and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of approved Agreement.
