Resolution retroactively approving an agreement between the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, and the Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr Inc for four programs: Defining Success: Academic Support Continuum, 6th-12th Grade; Beacon Pathways at Presidio Middle School (MS); Beacon Pathways at Roosevelt Middle School; and Multi-Cultural Arts Program: K-12 Art Pathways; for a total term of five years from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of \$10,366,200; and to authorize Department of Children, Youth and Families to enter into amendments or modifications to the Agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement or this Resolution.

WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for its 2024–2029 funding cycle; and

WHEREAS, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr Inc submitted proposals for four programs under RFP Result Area: All Children and Youth are Ready to Learn and Succeed in School; and

WHEREAS, The four programs are: Defining Success: Academic Support Continuum, 6th-12th Grade; Beacon Pathways at Presidio Middle School; Beacon Pathways at Roosevelt Middle School; and Multi-Cultural Arts Program: K-12 Art Pathways; and

WHEREAS, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr Inc was awarded funding in all four programs; and

Mayor Lurie BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, Under Defining Success: Academic Support Continuum, 6th-12th Grade Program, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr Inc will provide tutoring, summer transitions, high school and college prep workshops; and

WHEREAS, Under Beacon Pathways at Presidio Middle School Program, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr will provide expanded learning, engaging after school and school day enrichments and academics, behavioral health and wellness support, identity based clubs, restorative justice and culture program, and career awareness and transition support; and

WHEREAS, Under Beacon Pathways at Roosevelt Middle School Program, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr will provide project based learning, culturally responsive and SEL programs, expanded learning, afterschool and school day enrichments and academics, student of color success center, behavioral health and wellness supports, career awareness and transition supports; and

WHEREAS, Under Multi-Cultural Arts Program: K-12 Art Pathways, Richmond District Neighborhood Ctr will provide a developmentally appropriate continuum of visual, performing, and instrumental arts programs for marginalized youth from K to 12th grade; and

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and


WHEREAS, The proposed Agreement contained in File No. 241129, is substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively approves the Agreement in substantially the form contained in File No. 241129; and, be it

Mayor Lurie BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to make any modifications to the, prior to its final execution by all parties, that Department of Children, Youth and Their Families determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully executed by all parties, Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 241129; this requirement and obligation resides with the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of approved Agreement.
