WHEREAS, The California Employment Development Department is a pass-through entity for the United States Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Economic and Workforce Development received an additional \$1,404,844 in formula funds to support the WIOA Program at the discretion of the Department of Labor and the California Employment Development Department; and

WHEREAS, The California Employment Development Department modified the total WIOA Program award to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development to \$5,655,557 to support unemployment and underemployed adults, workers that have been displaced from the workforce, workers that are experiencing layoffs, and youth and young adults; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$565,555.70; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the California Employment Development Department may fund the Office of Economic and Workforce Development; and, be it

RESOLVED, That the Office of Economic and Workforce Development is responsible for the oversight of WIOA funding for the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Economic and Workforce Development to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a grant from the California Employment Development Department for the WIOA Program in the amount of \$5,655,557; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Office of Economic and Workforce Development is authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City.
