Resolution declaring a shelter crisis pursuant to Senate Bill 850 (Chapter 48, Statutes of 2018 and Government Code, Section 8698.2) and authorizing the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing to apply for funding under the California Homeless Emergency Aid Program.

[Declaration of Shelter Crisis and Authorizing the Application for the Homeless Emergency Aid

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco ("Board of Supervisors"), after careful study and consideration, has determined that there is a shortage of safe and sanitary housing throughout the City, particularly for no, low, and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, California's Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. and the members of the California Legislature have recognized the urgent and immediate need for funding at the local level to combat homelessness; and

WHEREAS, The Governor and Legislature have provided funding to local governments under the Homeless Emergency Aid Program as part of SB 850 and the 2018-19 Budget Act (Chapter 48, Statutes of 2018); and

WHEREAS, The Governor and Legislature require jurisdictions seeking an allocation through the Homeless Emergency Aid Program to declare a Shelter Crisis pursuant to Government Code, Section 8698.2; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco has developed a homelessness plan and undertaken multiple efforts at the local level to combat homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco finds that according to the San Francisco 2017 Point in Time Count 6,858 persons within the City and County of San

Francisco are homeless on any given night; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco finds that the number of homeless is significant, and these persons are without the ability to obtain shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco finds that the health and safety of unsheltered persons in San Francisco is threatened by a lack of shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco affirms San Francisco's commitment to combatting homelessness and creating or augmenting a continuum of shelter and service options for those living without shelter in our communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco that a shelter crisis pursuant to Government Code, Section 8698.2 exists in the City and County of San Francisco and authorizes the San Francisco's participation in the Homeless Emergency Aid Program; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing to apply for and administer funds from the Homeless Emergency Aid Program.
