Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to submit applications for Grant funds to the California Department of Health Care Services, through its contractor Advocates for Human Potential, Inc., under the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Bond Round 1 Launch Ready Program, pursuant to the Behavioral Health Infrastructure Bond Act of 2024, for a term not to exceed 10 years, with anticipated revenue to the City in excess of \$70,000,000; to enter into Grant Agreements, if one or more is awarded, including binding arbitration and/or a waiver of claims against the State or its third-party Grant Administrator; and authorizing SFDPH to enter into amendments or modifications to the Grant Agreements that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City and are necessary to effectuate the purpose of the Grant.

WHEREAS, On July 15, 2024, the California Department of Health Care Services (CDHCS), through its contractor Advocates for Human Potential, Inc., issued a Request for Applications for Grant funds distributed under the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Round 1 Launch Ready Program, pursuant to Behavioral Health Infrastructure Bond Act of 2024; and

WHEREAS, Program funding allocations are subject to the terms and conditions of the Requests for Applications, the Application, Program Funding Agreement, and all other legal requirements of the Program; and

WHEREAS, CDHCS requires that the governing body of the applicant jurisdiction formally pre-authorize the City to (1) submit applications for Grant funds; (2) accept Grant funds if DPH's Grant Applications are approved, with the understanding that all Grant funds

must be used for the allowable expenditures and activities identified in the Grant Agreement, and (3) agree to all Grant terms, including binding arbitration and/or a waiver of claims against CDHCS or its third-party Grant Administrator; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to submit the Applications to CDHCS for Program Grant funds in an amount anticipated to exceed \$70,000,000; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH acknowledges and agrees that it shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the Program Funding Agreements, and that any and all activities, expenditures, information, and timelines represented in the Applications are enforceable through the Program Funding Agreements; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the Applications are approved, SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter into the Grant Agreements for the total award amount, and is further hereby authorized to agree to all Grant Agreement terms, including binding arbitration and/or a waiver of claims against CDHCS or its third-party Grant Administrator; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That Grant funds are to be used for the allowable expenditures and activities identified in the Grant Agreements; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Health to execute the Applications and Program Documents on behalf of Applicant for participation in the Program and enter into any amendments or modifications to the Grant that the Department determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not otherwise materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Grant, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Program Funding Agreements being fully executed by all parties, DPH shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors the Grant Applications and a completely executed copy of the Program Funding Agreements

for inclusion in File No. 241097; this requirement and obligation resides with the Department, and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved Program Funding Agreements.
